Notice of Endangered Status For

Local 74 USWU Pension Fund

This is to inform you that on March 31, 2010 the plan actuary certified to the U.S. Department of the Treasury, and also to the plan sponsor, that the Local 74 USWU Pension Fund (the "Plan") is in seriously endangered status for the plan year beginning January 1, 2010.

Endangered Status

The plan is considered to be in seriously endangered status because it meets the standards of that status as set out by the 2006 Pension Protection Act ("PPA"). More specifically, the plan's actuary determined that the plan's funded percentage for 2010 is below 80%, and over the next seven plan years, the plan is projected to have an accumulated funding deficiency for the plan year ended December 31, 2015.

Funding Improvement Plan

Federal law requires pension plans in endangered or seriously endangered status to adopt a funding improvement plan aimed at restoring the financial health of the plan. This funding improvement plan must be submitted to the appropriate parties by November 25, 2010. The Trustees of the Plan will be working with our actuaries to put an appropriate funding improvement plan together, following the guidance under PPA.
