This is to inform you that on March 25, 2009 the enrolled actuary for the Plumbers & Steamfitters Local 47 Pension Plan (the "Plan") certified to the US Department of the Treasury, and also to the plan sponsor, that the Plan is in critical status for the plan year beginning January 1, 2009.

On January 20, 2009 the plan sponsor elected under the Worker, Retiree and Employer Recovery Act of 2008 §204(c)(1) to maintain for the 2009 plan year the 2008 plan year status where the Plan was not critical and not endangered. Federal law requires that you receive this notice.

Endangered / Critical status

The steps to improve the plan's funded situation may include increases in contributions and reductions in future benefit accruals as permitted by Federal law.
