## **General Comment**

Section 2711 applies to grandfathered group plans. This means that the highest annual limit that the grandfathered group plan could have is \$750,000. Section 1251 gives various scenarios as to ensure retention of grandfather status. If a grandfathered grup health plan had a \$1 million lifetime limit and no annual limit, does that plan need to set its new annual limit at no less than \$1 million to keep its grandfather status even though Section 2711 applies to it?
