I work at a women's community clinic in San Francisco, California where we provide free reproductive health services to uninsured and under-insured women. We see women walk out of our clinic every day with confidence about their reproductive health and choices because we helped them choose and obtain the right contraceptive method for them. This type of prevention of unplanned pregnancies and other reproductive health problems should be easily accessible to everyone, and a priority for the new health care system.
