General Comment

I wish to comment on the 10% threshold for translation and oral interpretation of private plan materials in the internal review and appeals contexts. I an individual who interacts with many LEP individuals, many of whom need assistance with their health care documents. The 10% standard is far too high. A more appropriate standard would be "5% of the plan's population or 500 persons in plan's service area" for large group plans, and 25% of population for small plans. Oral interpretation should be provided in all languages at all times, otherwise you are discriminating against those who don't speak English, and that is a violation of their civil rights. Please take this seriously. Thank you.
