Re: Request to Testify at Public Hearing on Proposed Amendment to Prohibited Transaction Class Exemption 84-14 – EBSA—2022-0008

The American Retirement Association (ARA) requests an opportunity to testify at the Department of Labor's (Department's) public hearing on the Proposed Amendment to Prohibited Transaction Class Exemption 84-14 (Proposed Amendment), to be held November 17, 2022.

The ARA is the coordinating entity for its five underlying affiliate organizations that represent the full spectrum of America's private retirement system: the American Society of Pension Professionals and Actuaries (ASPPA), the National Association of Plan Advisors (NAPA), the National Tax-Deferred Savings Association (NTSA), the American Society of Enrolled Actuaries (ASEA), and the Plan Sponsor Council of America (PSCA). ARA's members include organizations of all sizes and industries across the nation who sponsor and/or support retirement saving plans and are dedicated to expanding on the success of employer sponsored plans.
