Information and Instructions:

In General: The Office of Administrative Law Judges (OALJ) requires the filing of a Notice of Appearance by representatives. 29 C.F.R. § 18.22(a). To withdraw from the representation, an attorney or non-attorney representative must obtain leave from the presiding a dministrative law judge (ALJ). Because it is the representative's responsibility to file such a motion, and the client usually does not need to file a separate, additional motion. Section 22(e), however, permits a party to file a motion for withdrawal of the representation. This might be necessary, for example, if the party wishes to discharge the representative, and that representative cannot be relied on to file a motion to withdraw. Another example is where the representative becomes unavailable, incapacitated or has died. This form may be used for such a motion filed by the party (or the party's new representative).

Form fields:

Identification of Party and Representative: In the first paragraph of the form, you must identify yourself as the party filing the motion, and must identify the representative whose representation is requested to be ended.

New Representation: To assist the presiding ALJ in determining whether the withdrawal will cause undue delay or prejudice to the rights of a party, please provide information a bout how you will be represented going forward. If you are a new representative filing this motion on behalf of the party, you will need to also file a Notice of Appearance.

Prayer for relief and signature: If you are e-filing this motion, you may sign either by "/s/" followed by the filer's typed name, or by a digital signature.
