The employee was exposed to toluene at an 8-hour time weighted average (TWA) of 308.79 parts per million (ppm) of air, approximately 1.54 times the permissible exposure limit (PEL) of 200 ppm; ethylbenzene at an 8-hour TWA of 24.99 ppm of air, approximately 0.25 times the PEL of 100 ppm; and xylene at an 8-hour TWA of 117.32 ppm of air, approximately 1.17 times the PEL of 100 ppm. The exposure concentration was approximately 2.97 times the permissible 8-hour TWA concentration for the mixture. Sampling was performed for 450 minutes. Zero exposure was assumed for the 30 minute period not sampled.

This means that our bank will copy your check and use the account information on it to electronically debit your account for the amount of the check. The debit from your account will then usually occur within 24 hours and will be shown on your regular account statement. You will not receive your original check back.
