PROBLEM TO BE ADDRESSED	Concerns exist regarding the mandate, authority, professional status and career paths of Inspectors in the Ministries of Labor. A tradition of replacing technical level inspector positions with each change of government detracts from their objectivity and credibility, negates the value from previous training initiatives, and makes the Ministries less effective in carrying out their inspection responsibilities.

Create or identify requirements (e.g. course credit) for different levels of knowledge and experience for Inspectorate staff.3. Work within Labor Inspectorate Staff to develop or revise position descriptions and performance standards.4. Analyze together with the ministries to reform labor inspector personnel systems and develop civil service and tenure track system.5. Train labor inspectors and other personnel on operation of new civil service systems.6. Project closed/awaiting close out package
