





## UNEMPLOYMENT INSURANCE WEEKLY CLAIMS

## **SEASONALLY ADJUSTED DATA**

In the week ending February 15, the advance figure for seasonally adjusted **initial claims** was 210,000, an increase of 4,000 from the previous week's revised level. The previous week's level was revised up by 1,000 from 205,000 to 206,000. The 4-week moving average was 209,000, a decrease of 3,250 from the previous week's revised average. The previous week's average was revised up by 250 from 212,000 to 212,250.


The advance seasonally adjusted **insured unemployment rate** was 1.2 percent for the week ending February 8, unchanged from the previous week's unrevised rate. The advance number for seasonally adjusted **insured unemployment** during the week ending February 8 was 1,726,000, an increase of 25,000 from the previous week's revised level. The previous week's level was revised up 3,000 from 1,698,000 to 1,701,000. The 4-week moving average was 1,722,250, a decrease of 5,250 from the previous week's revised average. The previous week's average was revised up by 750 from 1,726,750 to 1,727,500.



## **UNADJUSTED DATA**

The advance number of actual initial claims under state programs, unadjusted, totaled 208,305 in the week ending February 15, a decrease of 11,296 (or -5.1 percent) from the previous week. The seasonal factors had expected a decrease of 15,833 (or -7.2 percent) from the previous week. There were 210,718 initial claims in the comparable week in 2019.

The advance unadjusted insured unemployment rate was 1.4 percent during the week ending February 8, unchanged from the prior week. The advance unadjusted number for persons claiming UI benefits in state programs totaled 2,090,131, an increase of 2,633 (or 0.1 percent) from the preceding week. The seasonal factors had expected a decrease of 27,221 (or -1.3 percent) from the previous week. A year earlier the rate was 1.5 percent and the volume was 2,084,585.



The total number of people claiming benefits in all programs for the week ending February 1 was 2,118,088, a decrease of 66,534 from the previous week. There were 2,177,074 persons claiming benefits in all programs in the comparable week in 2019.

No state was triggered "on" the Extended Benefits program during the week ending February 1.

Initial claims for UI benefits filed by former Federal civilian employees totaled 663 in the week ending February 8, a decrease of 85 from the prior week. There were 532 initial claims filed by newly discharged veterans, a decrease of 3 from the preceding week.

There were 11,456 former Federal civilian employees claiming UI benefits for the week ending February 1, an increase of 34 from the previous week. Newly discharged veterans claiming benefits totaled 5,493, a decrease of 230 from the prior week.

The highest insured unemployment rates in the week ending February 1 were in Alaska (3.0), New Jersey (2.7), Puerto Rico (2.7), Connecticut (2.5), Montana (2.5), West Virginia (2.5), Pennsylvania (2.4), Rhode Island (2.3), Illinois (2.2), and Minnesota (2.2).

The largest increases in initial claims for the week ending February 8 were in New Jersey (+984), Washington (+542), Virginia (+522), Nevada (+508), and Illinois (+451), while the largest decreases were in California (-3,066), New York (-1,535), Pennsylvania (-1,468), Missouri (-1,131), and Iowa (-687).

#### TECHNICAL NOTES

This news release presents the weekly unemployment insurance (UI) claims reported by each state's unemployment insurance program offices. These claims may be used for monitoring workload volume, assessing state program operations and for assessing labor market conditions. States initially report claims directly taken by the state liable for the benefit payments, regardless of where the claimant who filed the claim resided. These are the basis for the advance initial claims and continued claims reported each week. These data come from ETA 538, Advance Weekly Initial and Continued Claims Report. The following week initial claims and continued claims are revised based on a second reporting by states that reflect the claimants by state of residence. These data come from the ETA 539, Weekly Claims and Extended Benefits Trigger Data Report.

## A. Initial Claims

An initial claim is a claim filed by an unemployed individual after a separation from an employer. The claimant requests a determination of basic eligibility for the UI program. When an initial claim is filed with a state, certain programmatic activities take place and these result in activity counts including the count of initial claims. The count of U.S. initial claims for unemployment insurance is a leading economic indicator because it is an indication of emerging labor market conditions in the country. However, these are weekly administrative data which are difficult to seasonally adjust, making the series subject to some volatility.

## **B.** Continued Weeks Claimed

A person who has already filed an initial claim and who has experienced a week of unemployment then files a continued claim to claim benefits for that week of unemployment. Continued claims are also referred to as insured unemployment. The count of U.S. continued weeks claimed is also a good indicator of labor market conditions. Continued claims reflect the current number of insured unemployed workers filing for UI benefits in the nation. While continued claims are not a leading indicator (they roughly coincide with economic cycles at their peaks and lag at cycle troughs), they provide confirming evidence of the direction of the U.S. economy.

## C. Seasonal Adjustments and Annual Revisions

Over the course of a year, the weekly changes in the levels of initial claims and continued claims undergo regularly occurring fluctuations. These fluctuations may result from seasonal changes in weather, major holidays, the opening and closing of schools, or other similar events. Because these seasonal events follow a more or less regular pattern each year, their influence on the level of a series can be tempered by adjusting for regular seasonal variation. These adjustments make trend and cycle developments easier to spot. At the beginning of each calendar year, the Bureau of Labor Statistics provides the Employment and Training Administration (ETA) with a set of seasonal factors to apply to the unadjusted data during that year. Concurrent with the implementation and release of the new seasonal factors, ETA incorporates revisions to the UI claims historical series caused by updates to the unadjusted data.
