Notice of Critical Status for the 2010 Plan Year for Local 1245 Labor-Management Pension Plan

This is to inform you that on March 31, 2010 the plan actuary certified to the U.S. Department of the Treasury, and also to the Board of Trustees, that the Local 1245 Labor-Management Pension Plan ("Plan") continues to be in critical status for the plan year beginning January 1, 2010. Federal law requires that you receive this Notice.

Critical Status

The Plan is considered to be in critical status because the Plan's actuary has projected that a funding deficiency will occur on December 31, 2011. The Plan status is critical if a funding deficiency is projected within four years.

Rehabilitation Plan

Federal law requires pension plans in critical status to adopt a "Rehabilitation Plan" aimed at restoring the financial health of the plan. The Board of Trustees adopted a Rehabilitation Plan on October 26, 2009, which provides for contribution increases sufficient for the Plan to emerge from critical status within 13 years without any benefit reductions. Each year the Trustees will review the progress of the Plan to determine whether the Plan remains in critical status. If necessary, the Trustees will modify the Rehabilitation Plan to reflect any changed circumstances.

Employer Surcharge

The law requires that all contributing employers pay to the Plan a surcharge to help correct the Plan's financial situation. The amount of the surcharge is equal to a percentage of the amount an employer is otherwise required to contribute to the Plan under the applicable collective bargaining agreement. A 5% surcharge was implemented on June 1, 2009 and a 10% surcharge was implemented on January 1, 2010. These surcharges will cease to apply to any employer once its' Collective Bargaining Agreement is amended to comply with the Rehabilitation Plan.
