

Graphic Arts Local 62B Industry Pension Plan

This notice is being provided as a result of an election made under Section 204 of the Worker, Retiree and Employer Recovery Act of 2008 (WRERA). This is to inform you that during June 2009 the plan actuary certified to the U.S. Department of the Treasury, and also to the plan sponsor, that the Graphic Arts Local 62B Pension Fund (Plan) is in seriously endangered status for the plan year beginning April 1, 2009. Federal law requires that you receive this notice.

Endangered Status

Before any changes or modifications, the Plan was considered to be in seriously endangered status because it has funding or liquidity problems, or both. More specifically, the Plan's actuary determined that the Plan's funded percentage for the fiscal year beginning April 1, 2008 and April 1, 2009 was less than 70% (a comparison of the assets to the present value of accumulated benefits) and is projected to have an accumulated funding deficiency in the fiscal year ending March 31, 2015.

Funding Improvement Plan

Federal law requires pension plans in seriously endangered status to adopt a funding improvement plan aimed at restoring the financial health of the Plan. The law permits pension plans to reduce, or even eliminate, certain benefits as part of a funding improvement plan as well as increase contributions. If the Trustees of the Plan determine that benefit reductions or modifications are necessary, you will receive a separate notice identifying and explaining the effect of those reductions. As you are aware and have already been notified, the Trustees have eliminated the Cash Withdrawal Lump Sum Option. This change was required and necessary in order to start the process of getting the Plan out of the seriously endangered status and for the Plan to attempt to attain future stability.
