

Employment Recovery Activities

Employment and Training Services will be provided through local workforce offices to eligible dislocated workers, including Career Services, Training Services, Supportive Services, and Needs-Related Payments. CDLE will work with its local partners to streamline processes, expedite enrollments into career and training services, and work with its partner agencies to ensure that all workers receive the services they need, when they need them, and return to work as quickly as possible.

Eligible Participants

Workers laid off due to quarantine orders or business closures related to disruptions caused by the outbreak are eligible participants. Also eligible are workers unable to go to their regular workplace due to social distancing requirements, as well as those missing work to care for a family member.
