### Project Overview

Career and Training services will be provided utilizing this grant. The project will utilize Individual Training Accounts (ITAs) and On-the-Job Training (OJT) to retrain dislocated workers who have been unemployed for an extended period of time or who have exhausted UI or other Pandemic Unemployment Insurance programs.



### Project Description

Provide career and training services, including Individual Training Accounts, on-the-job training, and case management to re-train dislocated workers; provide supportive services including books, supplies, and tuition; host virtual job fairs.



### Project Goals

The goal of the program is to help reemploy dislocated workers most affected by the economic and employment fallout from the COVID-19 pandemic, in particular those from historically marginalized communities or groups, and those who have been unemployed for an extended period of time or who have exhausted Unemployment Insurance (UI) or other COVID-19-related UI programs.
