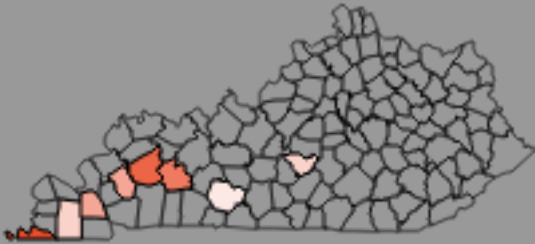

## Qualifying Events

On December 10, 2021, Kentucky experienced one of the deadliest tornado events in the Commonwealth's history. The Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) issued the major disaster declaration Kentucky Severe Storms, Straight-line Winds, Flooding, and Tornadoes (4630-DR-KY) on December 12, 2021.







## Proposal Summary

The Kentucky Office of Employment and Training submitted an emergency application for a Disaster Recovery National Dislocated Worker Grant (DWG). The proposed funds will provide disaster-relief employment for eligible individuals to assist with cleanup and recovery activities in response to the severe storms, straight-line winds, flooding, and tornadoes that occurred in December 2021.



## Project Description

The Commonwealth is requesting DWG funding for the creation of disaster-relief jobs focusing on debris cleanup, emergency protective measures, and humanitarian assistance to aid in the recovery effort.
