

Priority will go to those who have never worked, had legal problems, or been unemployed for an extended time; juniors, seniors in high school, and dropouts, justice-impacted individuals and groups facing employment barriers to higher-skilled occupations. Smaller communities in rural areas with a history of disenfranchising, underrepresented, and disregarded, will be targeted through

worker-centered sector plan projects.

This project will focus on establishing or expanding publicprivate partnerships and engaging businesses, employees, labor, and education and training institutions in adopting and deploying employment and training services to meet workforce needs. This grant will transform the system via workercentered sector policies and public-private partnerships. KY QUEST will continually recruit new partners through business outreach and education. Community and potential participant outreach activities will include creating a targeted outreach effort with partners to reach historically underrepresented populations and participate in the Chamber of Commerce's Workforce events.
