Project Overview

The 2023 QUEST Disaster Recovery DWG project will provide employment and training services to underserved and historically marginalized communities, including those who identify as people of color, women, low-income, veterans, restored citizens, and immigrants who were disproportionately impacted by layoffs during the pandemic and are underrepresented in the automotive/electric vehicle industry.



Project Description

The project will provide strategic partnership activities which will focus on statewide and regional manufacturing associations to coordinate and scale regional sector partnerships, and training strategies, and create pathways into good jobs. Community and potential participant outreach activities will be conducted by the local workforce development boards, their service providers, and communitybased organization partners to identify target populations in the 23-county service delivery area.
