



Project UP is an initiative meant to uplift people by upskilling their talents and giving their life a new trajectory. Haywood Community College will partner with the Haywood County Detention Center, the local workforce board, and construction, plumbing and Heating Ventilation and Air Conditioning businesses in the county to implement a training program to target local workforce needs. This initiative will provide a pathway for inmate rehabilitation and re-entry into the workforce with General Educational Development certification and job skills training. The program will also serve as a pipeline of entrylevel talent in the construction industry for businesses struggling to fill their workforce needs in high demand occupations.
