#### What's New:

#### File Upload Enhancements

- Schema Name
  - Target Programs
    - If you select a multi-program schema, listed below, then you will be required to select the Target Program(s). The Target Program(s) will determine which Duplicate Rules and Logical Rules will be applied to the uploaded file. The Target Program(s) will also determine which Performance Reports will be generated.
      - Multi-Program Schemas are
        - Full PIRL
        - WIASPR
        - WIOA\_WP\_DWG
        - WIOA\_WP
      - If you select a single program schema, such as H-1B, then the Target Program will be the same as the single program schema
      - H-1B schema has been revised from 109 data elements to 84
      - H-1B Quarterly Performance Reports can no longer be generated using the Full PIRL schema
    - Choose a File
      - Compressed files may now be uploaded in GNU Gzip format, but must have “.gz” extension

#### Edit Check Enhancements

- Target Programs
  - Duplicate and Logical Rule edit checks are now run based on the following criteria (Note that Valid Value

rules run on each element in the file regardless of the criteria selected)

- Target Program(s) selection
- Affected Program(s) for the rule
- Program Flags in uploaded file
