**SUBJECT :** PY 2001 Youth Supplemental Funds

1. **Purpose.** To transmit the Revised WIA Youth Activities State Allotment table.

3. **Background.** On August 16, 2001 TEGL No. 3-01, PY 2001 Changes in Dislocated Worker and Youth Funds, was issued to the employment and training system. The TEGL stated that an additional \$25 million is being made available for Youth activities in PY 2001 as a result of the Supplemental Appropriations Act 2001. The table reflecting the revised state allotments for WIA Youth Activities was not included. However, it is now available for dissemination.
