Attachment C Conversion Procedures - PY 1999 WIASR to PY 2000 WIASRD

States that implemented WIA early were required to report information of individuals using the WIASR format (7/8/99). The WIASR format is similar to the WIASRD format required for PY 2000. However, there are differences that will require care in converting data. This document provides special instructions regarding WIASRD reporting for individuals in early implementing states who either exited during PY 1999 or carried over from PY 1999 to PY 2000.

General Instructions

Retroactive data collection will not be required. However, states must convert relevant WIASR items into WIASRD items. The attached table provides a crosswalk between WIASRD items and codes and WIASR items and codes and provides additional instructions on converting WIASR items into WIASRD items.

States should also report WIASRD items that are included in the state's data system, but not on the WIASR.

General procedures include:

- Section I Individual Characteristics. All items with a corresponding item in the WIASR should be converted from the WIASR item according to the attached instructions. For items not on the WIASR and not in the state's data system, please leave the item blank (for example, if the data are not available leave the item blank, do not record a 'no'). There is no need to collect information that is not available.
- Section II Activity and Services Information. States should convert WIASR items into WIASRD items according the attached instructions. In addition, all activities and services received under WIA after July 1, 2000 should be reported according to the WIASRD instructions.
- Section IIIA and Section IIIB Program Outcomes. Most WIASRD outcomes can be determined from WIASR outcomes. Those that cannot be converted must still be reported if the information is in the state's data system. Full outcome information is expected to be available for adults, dislocated workers and older youth who exited on or after October 1, 1999 and younger youth who exited on or after July 1, 2000 because that information is required for the PY 2000 performance measures.
- C The first WIASRD submission should include records for all individuals who exited from WIA either in PY 2000 or PY 1999

Specific Instructions

- C Date Fields. All date fields have the same format (YYYYMMDD) in both the WIASRD and WIASR.
- Race and Ethnicity. With the WIASRD, race and ethnicity are split into two items; these items were combined on the WIASR (WIASR Item 7). In addition, multiple races are allowed on the WIASRD.
 - If the person's WIASR race/ethnicity is Hispanic ('3'), WIASRD ethnicity (Item 105) should be reported as Hispanic ('1') and all race fields (Items 106 to 110) should be left blank (because the individual's race is not known).
 - If a person's WIASR race/ethnicity is not Hispanic (other than '3'), the appropriate race on the WIASRD should be reported as yes ('1') in Items 106 to 110; the other races should be reported as 'no' ('2'); and Ethnicity (Item 105) should be reported as 'not Hispanic' ('2').
- Disability, Item 104. The WIASR did not distinguish between disabilities that are a substantial barrier to employment and those that are not. All disabilities recorded in the WIASR format should be reported on the WIASRD as disabilities that are a substantial barrier to employment (code '2') because previous data indicate that most reported disabilities are a substantial barrier to employment.
- C Activities and services.
 - Adults and dislocated workers. Reporting for adult and dislocated worker services is almost identical in the WIASR and WIASRD.
 - Youth. The WIASRD treats youth services activities differently. If detailed data on youth services are available to the state, youth services should be reported according to the WIASRD definitions. If detailed data, are not available, the approximate conversion shown in the chart should be issued.
