ROW.6	Job Search Activities	Count of all registered job seekers provided services which are designed to help the job seeker plan and carry out a successful job hunting strategy. The services include resume preparation assistance, job search workshops, including the Transition Assistance Program (TAP) workshops , job finding clubs, provision of specific labor market information and development of a job search plan. "Resume Assistance" – Providing instructions on the content and format of resumes and cover letters and providing assistance in the development and production of the same. "Job Search Workshops" – An organized activity that provides instructions on resume writing, application preparation, interviewing skills, and/or job lead development. "Job Finding Clubs" – have all the elements of the ES Job Search Workshop, plus a period of structured application where participants attempt to obtain jobs. "Provision of Specific Labor Market Information" – Information concerning occupational staffing patterns, hiring patterns, working conditions, and pay of firms or industries. "Job Search Planning" – Development of a plan (not necessarily a written plan) that includes the necessary steps and timetables to achieve employment in specific occupational, industry, or geographic area.
