

Because both exit dates occurred within the same program year (July 2016 – June 2017), the participant has two periods of participation for PY2016. Therefore, exit-based performance indicators should be collected and calculated based off **both** periods of participation; two separate outcomes will be based on the November 2016 exit and May 2017 exit, respectively.
