12. Brief summary of the proposed project: Kern Community College District (KCCD) is applying on behalf of Bakersfield College (BC) for the DOL Job Corp Program Scholars Demonstration Project. The project's goal is to recruit 2 separate cohorts for a total of 80 Job Corps Scholars. Project will offer stackable certificates in 8 different pathways to earn industry recognized certificates and internships. The project will hire personal and career counselors and employment counselors, and provide supportive services and materials to the students. Outcomes: Job Corps Scholars Separation Rate 60# & 75%; Job Corps Scholars Dropout Rate 10# & 12.5%; Job Corps Scholars Qualifying Placement Rate Upon Separation 62# & 77.5%; Job Corps Scholars Qualifying Placement Rate During the 12-month Employment Counseling Period Post-Separation 60# & 75%; Job Corps Scholars Starting Salary/Wage Qualifying Placement Upon Separation \$13 an hour; Job Corps Scholars Average Salary/Wage When in a Qualifying Placement 12 months After Separation \$20 an hour; Job Corps Scholars Average Earned Academic Credit Hours 12 hours; Job Corps Scholars Enrolled in the Armed Services Upon Separation; 2 & .025%; Job Corps Scholars Enrolled - Apprenticeship Program @ Separation 40# & 50%; Job Corps Scholars with Full-time Employment Upon Separation 40# & 50%.
