FOREWORD

This bibliography is a listing of unemployment insurance research and related documents which has been entered on a programmable word processor in the Unemployment Insurance Service. The intent has been to provide a selected listing of documents published after 1979 together with references to related bibliographies and research summaries regardless of when published.

The bibliography is presented in two parts. Part I is organized by subject and provides abbreviated information on each entry. A separate list of the subject headings is provided for quick reference. Part II is organized by author; Part II provides complete source information on each entry and a brief description of content when this is available. The notation DOL indicates that the document is in the Department of Labor Library. Library of Congress, National Technical Information Service, and Online Computer Library Center call numbers are included when known.

Because this new unemployment insurance bibliography is on a programmable computer, the data base can be easily expanded and updated for subsequent editions.
