- Through specialized technical assistance and methodological and instrumental support, the Ministry of Labor has improved strategic labor legislation application and thus can provide a more modern and efficient service to citizens.

Achievements



Inspection

- Design, development and implementation of a new Integrated Labor Inspection Cases System (SICIT), including user training and self-training manuals in digital and audiovisual formats.
- Training program design and implementation for approximately 200 inspectors, local representatives, and other Ministry of Labor officials on labor rights,

investigation techniques, and interpersonal skills.

Regulatory and methodological inspection tool update and compilation in a single document. Training all inspectors, local representatives, and supervisors on its use, to support their work.



Mediation and Arbitration

- Design and implementation of seminars-workshops on collective bargaining, conflict resolution, and social dialogue, among others, for the Ministry of Labor's 25 mediators, one of which was attended by worker and employer representatives.
- Mediation training program implemented for trainers, which includes conflict management and negotiation process competency development.



Strengthening of the Directorate for the Prevention and Eradication of Child Labor:

- Child Labor Directorate Diagnosis.
- Training multipliers on child labor.
- The Child Labor Directorate's intra-institutional action protocol.
- Proposal to update the Dangerous Jobs list through tripartite consultations.
- Experience sharing to observe the Office for the Attention and Eradication of Child Labor and Protection of Adolescent Workers' (OATIA) management model in Costa Rica.

Directorate for the Prevention and Eradication of Child Labor leadership strengthening in the inter-institutional articulation against child labor:

- Development and support for the implementation of the DAR-CE methodology between the Ministry of Labor, the Supérate program, and CONANI:
 - More than 50 national representatives of the institutions involved were trained in the method.

- More than 250 facilitators trained in 10 provinces.
- Community level multiplication with more than 500 participants.

Improved implementation of institutional initiatives related to acceptable work conditions and child labor by key actors:

- Awareness campaigns on issues related to child labor:
 - "Lanza tu dardo contra el Trabajo Infantil" campaign ("Throw Your Dart Against Child Labor"), 2020.
 - "Cambiando Patrones contra el Trabajo Infantil" Campaign ("Changing Patterns Against Child Labor"), 2022.
- Four children's stories produced on issues related to children's rights:
 - Julian Did Not Go to School
 - Estrellita's Rights
 - The Best Steps
 - A Day to Remember.



Achievements

- Performances of puppet shows based on these children's stories were performed in more than 10 of the country's localities.
- The protocol for inter-institutional coordination in the prevention and eradication of child labor for National Steering Committee (CDN) entities was updated.
- Support the CDN's Annual Operating Plan (POA) preparation for 2022 and 2023, including a monitoring tool; likewise, one for the Local Steering Committees (CDL).



- Training on issues like provision of public employment services, labor market prospective analysis, public employment systems challenges and opportunities, among others, for officials of the General Directorate of Employment of the Ministry of Labor.
- Provincial studies on mapping labor market supply and demand in Santiago, Duarte, and San Juan.
- Training program design and implementation in response to labor demand identified in the provincial studies, aimed at 400 people from families vulnerable to child labor, including guidance and support on employment access and insertion in local companies.



Industrial Hygiene and Safety

- Proposal design for a National Policy on Occupational Safety and Health (OSH).
- "Strategic Vision" document development and roadmap for its implementation.
- Preparation of a guide for the use and application of pesticides, and training of company Mixed Committees in 9 provinces on its use.
