Resource utilization and use of the Ministry of Labor's technological platform.

It is very useful for the programming, management, and follow-up of the inspection process, for registration of all data collected in the process, and for generating statistical reports.



 It allows for the articulation with other systems of the Ministry of Labor and other public institutions.



 It is a user-friendly system for labor inspection personnel.



Can be used online, available via the Internet, and accessed from a PC, tablet, cell phone, or both).



All labor inspectors, local representatives, supervisors, and managers related to SICIT have been trained to use this tool.



 Officials received a handbook and audio-visual self-training material for using the system.
