DETERMINATION

Determination of a Complaint Filed under Title IV
of the Labor-Management Reporting and Disclosure Act of 1959

On August 5, 2019, the Secretary of Labor received a complaint alleging violations of Section 401 of the Labor-Management Reporting and Disclosure Act of 1959 (LMRDA), regarding the regularly scheduled election of officers scheduled for August 2018 by United Production Workers Local 17-18 in Brooklyn, New York.


Pursuant to Sections 402 and 601 of the LMRDA, the Department of Labor conducted an investigation. The investigation disclosed that Local 17-18 failed to hold its regularly scheduled election of officers.

Apprised of these findings, UPWU Local 17-18 agreed to conduct nominations and an election of officers under the supervision of the Secretary of Labor, in accordance with Title IV of the LMRDA. The agreed upon remedial election was concluded on December 14, 2020. It is, therefore,

DETERMINED, that there is probable cause to believe that violations of Title IV of the LMRDA occurred with regard to United Production Workers Local 17-18's 2018 regularly scheduled election of officers but that these violations have been remedied by the election, conducted in accordance with Title IV of the LMRDA, under the supervision of the Secretary of Labor, on December 14, 2020.

Therefore, civil action under Section 402(b) of the LMRDA is not warranted.
