Secretary of Labor R. Alexander Acosta (the "Secretary") petitions for summary entry of a judgment against Respondent Casey Bortles enforcing nine final orders of the Occupational Safety and Health Review Commission (the "Commission"). Casey Bortles has not answered the petition for summary enforcement.

Section 11(b) of the Occupational Safety and Health Act of 1970 (the "Act"), 29 U.S.C. § 660(b), provides that, if no petition for review of a final order is filed and the Secretary petitions for enforcement, "the Commission's findings of fact and order shall be conclusive," thus authorizing summary enforcement of the final order. *See Brennan v. Winters Battery Mfg. Co.*, 531 F.2d 317, 321–324 (6th Cir. 1975). And, if an employer does not contest a citation or proposed penalty, it "shall be deemed a final order of the Commission and not subject to review by any court or agency." 29 U.S.C. § 659(a),(b). Casey Bortles did not contest the nine citations or petition for review of the resulting final orders of the Commission.

Accordingly, the Commission's final orders, resulting from the uncontested Citations and Notifications of Penalty issued under OSHA Inspection Numbers 962398, 1066332, 1231170 (two orders), 1266246, 1273009 (two orders), 1311484, and 1331306, are hereby **ENFORCED**; and Casey Bortles shall:

- Comply with the final orders resulting from the uncontested Citations and Notifications of Penalty issued under OSHA Inspection Numbers 962398, 1066332, 1231170, 1266246, 1273009, 1311484, and 1331306, requiring abatement of the enumerated violations of the Act;
- 2. Pay the Secretary, within ten days of the date of this judgment, the \$341,972 in penalties assessed by the final orders, plus accrued interest from the date each order became final through the date of payment;
- 3. Submit to Kimberly Nelson, Area Director of the OSHA Toledo Area Office, within ten days of the date of this judgment, abatement certification and abatement documentation for the violations of 29 C.F.R. § 1926.20(b)(1), 29 C.F.R. § 1926.20(b)(2), 29 C.F.R. § 1926.21(b)(2), 29 C.F.R. § 1926.95(a); 29 C.F.R. § 1926.451(e)(1), 29 C.F.R. § 1926.451(g)(1)(i); 29 C.F.R. § 1926.501(b)(13), 29 C.F.R. § 1926.503(a)(1), 29 C.F.R. § 1926.503(c), and 29 C.F.R. § 1926.1053(b)(1), as required by the final orders resulting from the uncontested Citations and Notifications of Penalty issued under OSHA Inspection Numbers 962398, 1066332, 1231170, 1266246, 1273009, 1311484, and 1331306.
- Cease and desist from violating in any like or relate manner 29 C.F.R. § 1903.19(c)(1), 29 C.F.R. § 1926.20(b)(1), 29 C.F.R. § 1926.20(b)(2), 29 C.F.R. § 1926.21(b)(2), 29 C.F.R. § 1926.95(a); 29 C.F.R. § 1926.451(e)(1), 29 C.F.R.
