Ohio Department of Job and Family Services (ODJFS)

ODJFS will work mainly through its Area 1 leadership in providing WIOA Adult and Dislocated Worker program services and business services to local employers through the Business Resource Network (BRN) of over 50 partners and the Workforce Development Centers. Area 1 plans to provide innovative and much needed incumbent worker training to local employers and their current workforce, developing customized training plans that lead to credentialing for in-demand occupations in high growth industries. The BRN has 25 business customers who identify themselves as opioid and substance abuse treatment providers. Area 1, under the ODJFS, has also been the recipient of two other DOL grants, also related to the opioid crisis. Through those grants, the ODJFS has already established partnerships to serve this population.

The target occupations include occupations related to both people affected by the opioid crisis as well as people not personally affected. They are both in the healthcare profession as well as indemand occupations in other professional fields.

The target populations will be Dislocated Workers, Individuals with Barriers to Employment, New Entrants to the Workforce, Incumbent Workers, and specifically those who have been personally affected by the opioid crisis as well as workers seeking to enter professions that could help address the opioid crisis and its causes.
