ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL

On January 10, 2022 appellant sought an appeal from a purported January 4, 2022 decision of the Office of Workers' Compensation Programs (OWCP). The Clerk of the Appellate Boards assigned the appeal Docket No. 22-0354.

The Board has duly considered the matter and notes that the Board has jurisdiction to review final adverse decisions of OWCP issued under the Federal Employees' Compensation Act (FECA). This jurisdiction encompasses any final decision issued by OWCP within 180 days of the date appellant filed his appeal. The Board notes that the case record as transmitted to the Board neither contains a final adverse decision of OWCP dated January 4, 2022, nor a final adverse decision of OWCP issued within 180 days from the date of docketing of the current appeal.
