<u>Information</u> Correction Request for Salem Glass Company

Dear Mr. Smith:

On behalf of Salem Glass Company (Salem), I respectfully submit this Information Correction Request. Salem requests that the detail for Inspection 312908791 on OSHA's IMIS system be corrected to indicate that the last event in the inspection was "W-Withdrawn," as opposed to "F-Formal Settlement," which is currently listed on the system. Salem's reasons for this change follow.

Inspection 312908791 – Salem Glass Company, attached as Exhibit A, reflects an investigation initiated by OSHA in October 2008. OSHA issued two citation items against Salem at the conclusion of that inspection, which Salem contested. As a result of discussions with Department of Labor officials regarding the case, DOL withdrew all citation items issued, as reflected in the "Withdrawal of Citation and Complaint" (attached as Exhibit B). DOL filed the withdrawal with the Occupational Safety and Health Review Commission and it was subsequently granted by Administrative Law Judge Bober. It is clear from the attached paperwork that DOL withdrew its citation and complaint and there was no formal settlement.

Notwithstanding this, the IMIS system currently shows Inspection 31290871 as having the last event be "F-Formal Settlement." To accurately reflect the last event in this case, Salem respectfully requests that the last event be changed to "W-Withdrawn." Salem requests that this change be made in the main entry (Exhibit A), as well as in the violation item details, shown in Exhibit C.

For obvious reasons, Salem has a clear interest in correcting this entry. DOL withdrew its citation and complaint in this action. It is critical that the IMIS entry be corrected to accurately reflect the resolution of the case.
