## **SENTENCING**

The Government had five witnesses who wanted to address the Court concerning the impact of the defendant's actions.

Pursuant to Rule 11(c)(1)(C), the Court imposes sentence as follows:

The defendant will be placed on probation for a term of five years. Restitution in the amount of \$196,483.08 . All payments will be made through the Clerk of the Court. There is no fine imposed.

Mandatory and Standard conditions of release imposed. Defendant will be allowed to be self-employed in his current business with Bullseye under the supervision of the Probation Office. Mandatory special assessment of \$25.00 imposed. Defendant is advised of his right to appeal. Court adjourned.
