Stop and Shelter Repairs/Refurbishments for Lakeland Area Mass Transit District (LAMTD). The useful life for these repairs/refurbishments is 15 years. Lakeland Area Mass Transit District (LAMTD) will be refurbishing a shelter at a rural bus stop. The shelter refurbishment will include replacing solar lighting, replacement of plastic panels and paint. Additionally, LAMTD will be constructing a ADA compliant pad at rural bus stops.
