This is an FY 2021 Section 5311 Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act (CRRSAA) (FHWA Flex HIP fund) Highway Infrastructure Program in the amount of \$230,129. 100% federal share of the total eligible amount. This application utilizes CRRSAA funding to prevent, prepare for, and respond to coronavirus. The application scope of work includes computer/computer equipment, transit technology purchases (new CAD/AVL systems), propane trolley, boiler replacement, CRRSAA Special Eligibility - operations - coverage for one-time extra compensation, building improvements/enhancements and bus purchase.
