The contracted agencies will provide transit vehicles, drivers, and administrative support to provide the transit services in and around Grand Ronde.

Activities to be performed:

Activities to be performed include operating assistance.

Expected outcomes:

Expected outcomes are that Tillamook County will continue providing three transit routes in and out of Grand Ronde. The routes are the 60X Coastal Connector the provides transit services between Grand Ronde and Lincoln City, Oregon; along with the 60X route between Grand Ronde and Salem, Oregon. Tillamook County will also provide Route 70X, the Grand Ronde Express for transit services between Grand Ronde and Salem. Yamhill County Transit will provide transit services for Route 22 from Grand Ronde to McMinnville.

Intended beneficiaries:

Intended beneficiaries are Elders, younger population too young to obtain driver's licenses, families with limited or no access to automobiles, commuters, access to employment, and community members accessing services in Grand Ronde.
