The Tribe did not meet the reporting deadlines, and was informed they would need to pay back the grant. Information was provided to HRSA to negotiate the reimbursement amount, and this was rejected. The debt was forwarded to the Treasury and we are working to determine the process to complete the re payment back to the Treasury. This will be done soon.
