D2022-TRTR-022 \$415,580 Replace 2 buses LAPSING FUNDS

Jicarilla Apache Nation seeks FTA funding for a capital project to purchase two cutaway style transit buses to operate on the North Central Regional Transit District (NCRTD) 170 Jicarilla bus route serving Jicarilla Apache Nation. The two new buses will replace two NCRTD buses that will exceed their useful life before the new buses are delivered.

The project is necessary to maintain the state of good repair of transit assets, accommodate the physical characteristics of the route, meet the high demand for transit in the area, improve passenger and operator comfort, advance environmental sustainability, make up for limited availability of transit funding, and promote coordination between local government agencies. The project will benefit current passengers, Jicarilla Apache Nations roughly 3,356 residents, and people working in and visiting the area. It is supported by Jicarilla Apache Nation tribal members and government, NCRTD, and demographic and survey data.

When the Tribal Transit Program (TTP) funding is awarded, NCRTD will complete the project on behalf of Jicarilla Apache Nation and continue to provide transit service on the route, and Jicarilla Apache Nation will sub-allocate the funding to NCRTD. NCRTD has the proven technical, legal and financial capacity to complete the project in a cost-efficient, time-efficient, high-quality manner. NCRTD has successfully procured over 100 buses, two using TTP competitive funding.
